JUSTICE & SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT THROUGH A LENS OF MERCY

Sun, 18 June - Fri, 23 June

Dublin, Ireland

This justice focused five-day retreat will explore justice and the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals through a lens of Mercy. We will discuss intersectional justice issues, the Mercy justice advocacy model, and what a future of sustainable development looks like for all.

CREATIVE MEDITATION RETREAT

SILENT CENTERING PRAYER RETREAT

This five-day retreat will provide a contemplative space to centre yourself in prayer and explore a call to deeper listening. This silent method of meditation will lead participants on a journey of connectedness to Catherine. The retreat will include time in Catherine's house at Baggot Street, and access to spiritual direction.

ECO-SPIRITUALITY & THE 8TH WORK OF MERCY Sun, 3 September - Fri, 8 September

Dublin, Ireland

This five-day retreat will provide spiritual context to ecological sustainability and deepen your connection to creation. The transformative relationship of humans and earth will be explored while also providing time for reflection and time in nature. Additionally, participants will examine the 8th work of Mercy and our call to corporal and spiritual action.

SABBATICAL

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 1 - SATURDAY, OCTOBER 28

This four-week gentle retreat will balance speakers, sessions, and reflective time in Catherine's house. Participants will be led on a journey to explore our Mercy roots, have access to spiritual direction, and be provided with thoughtful materials for contemplation and renewal. Weekends will be free for participants to immerse themselves in the local community and Irish culture.

RESIDENTIAL COST: €4250

The cost of the programme includes accommodation at Baggot Street and all meals. Stipends will be provided for occasional dinners out. Participants will receive a welcome packet with a prepaid local transportation card, visitor passes to local museums and churches, and access cards and information for day trips to Irish and Mercy heritage sites. Optional pilgrimages to Knock Shrine and Glendalough is included.

WHY SABBATICAL AT MIA

Catherine McAuley wrote "Won't you pray fervently that we may all have a profitable holy retreat. May almighty God helps us to make it well." A sabbatical experience at MIC in Dublin provides the opportunity for a profitable, holy retreat by providing space for rest and rejuvenation, spending time in Catherine's house, and learning more about the culture and traditions where Mercy was born.
