In April, Mercy Beyond Borders hosted the Seeds of Change Gala, which was an evening brimming with generosity and warmth, championing the education and empowerment of women and girls living in extreme poverty across five countries.

Thanks to the overwhelming support of the MBB community, our donors pledged an impressive \$312,555, exceeding our goal! As of today, we've received \$241,816.55.

This incredible sum fuels a multitude of impactful initiatives. It supports high school and university scholarships for 442 girls and enriches them with leadership workshops and computer training, all with case management support.

It also supports the education of over 1,500 girls in Haiti & South Sudan at the primary level, including 70 survivors of forced marriage, who live year-round on campus unable to ever go home again.

Donor generosity is also empowering 250 refugee women heads-of-households and their families by training them in perma-gardening techniques and providing business training and grants to launch their own businesses.
