



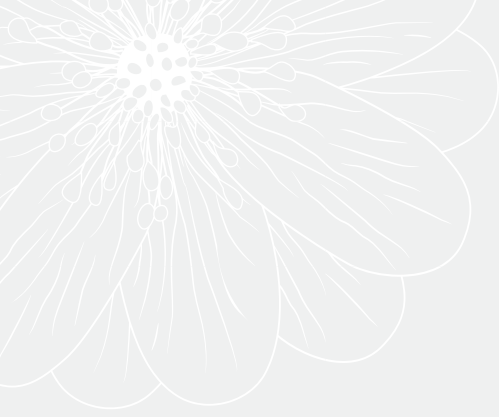

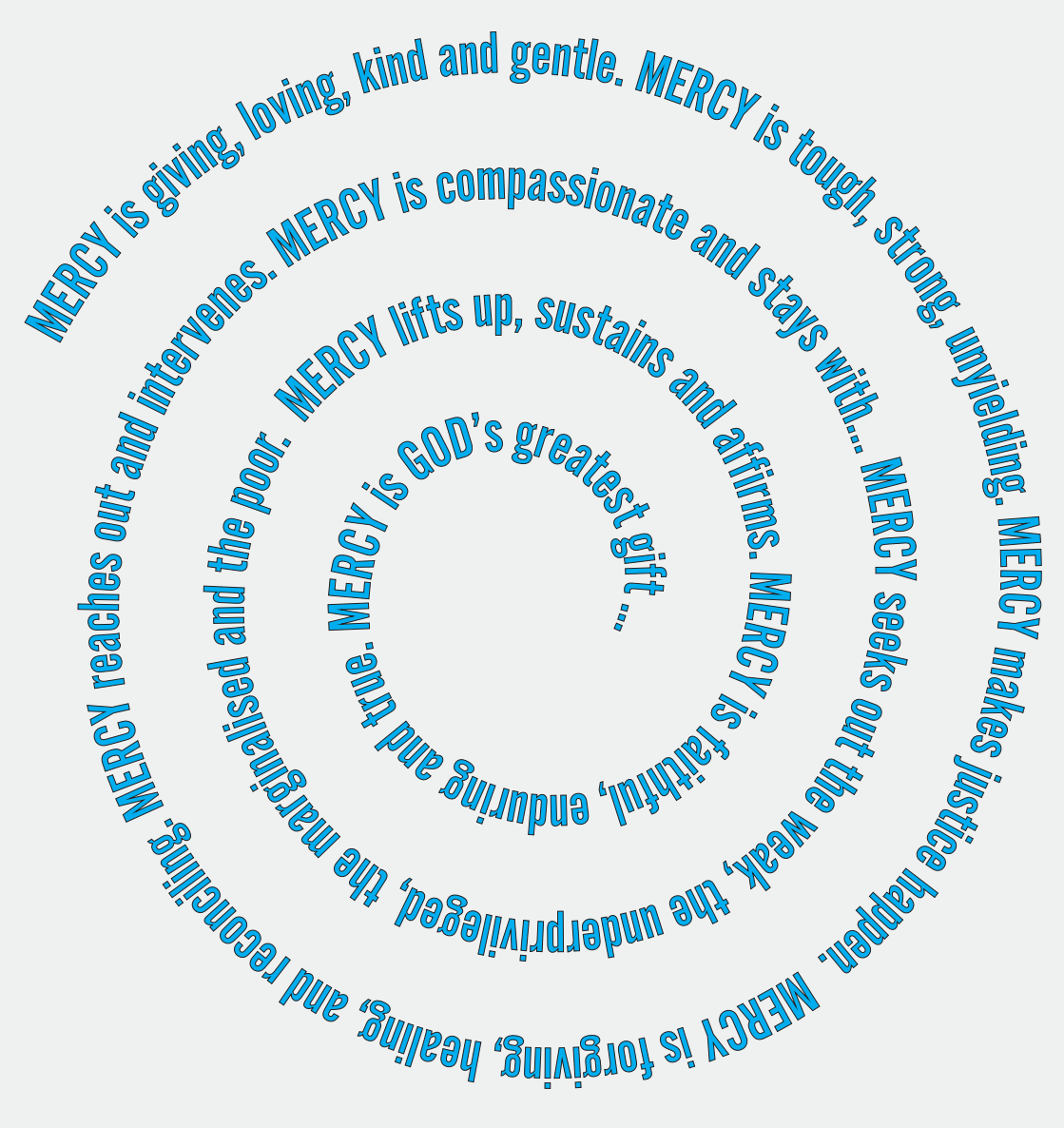
Eucharistic Prayer Responses
