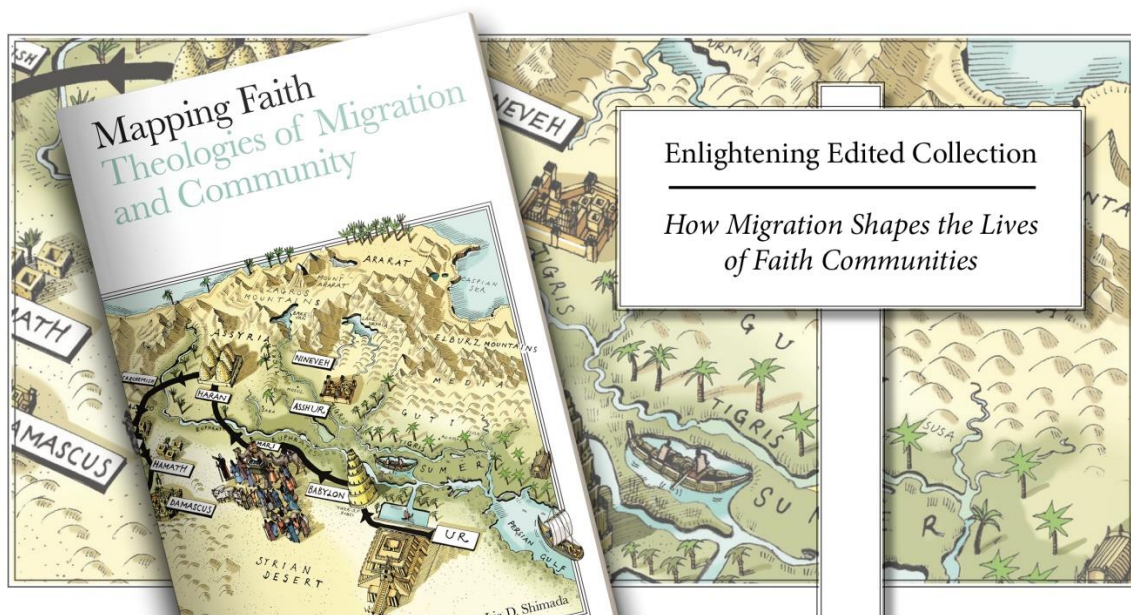


Dublin City Interfaith Forum invites you to the launch of:
