


# Mercy Global Action affirms the rights of



## REFUGEES

The United Nations 1951 <u>Refugee Convention</u> defines a refugee as someone crossing international borders to flee "a well-founded fear of persecution because of his/her race, religion, nationality, membership in a particular social group, or political opinion."

The main principle of the convention is <u>non-refoulement</u>, which means that a refugee should not be returned to an unsafe environment.

#### 80% OF REFUGEES


When people must flee, about <u>80%</u> of refugees stay in countries neighboring their own.



#### RIGHTS OF REFUGEES

- The right not to be expelled, except under certain, strictly defined conditions;
- The right not to be punished for illegal entry into the territory of a contracting State;
- The right to work;
- The right to housing;
- The right to education;
- The right to public relief and assistance;
- The right to freedom of religion;
- The right to access the courts;
- The right to freedom of movement within the territory;
- The right to be issued identity and travel documents.
